

OPUS THEATRE

DIRECTIONS & PARKING

Opus Theatre is located on 24 Cambridge Road, Hastings, East Sussex TN34 1HG, in Hastings town centre, just a few minutes walk from Hastings bus and train stations. We reside in a Grade 2 listed building dating back to 1885.

There is extensive on street parking nearby in Cambridge Gardens after 6pm and inexpensive parking in the Priory Street Multi Storey Car Park for £1.30 per hour (reduced thereafter) and free from 9pm to 11pm.

Alternatively, there is parking at several Pay & Display options in walking distance from the venue (see below).


Disabled access available at the back of the venue on Robertson Street, between 'Rye Bay Cafe' and 'Racer Computers'. If the door is closed please ring the doorbell, situated under the handrail. Alternatively, you can phone us on: 07940 564 734. Stair-Lift access and ramp available. (Currently, we are unable to facilitate access to electric wheelchair users. You will be required to transfer onto the Stair Lift and your wheelchair will be carried upstairs for you. Plans for a stair walker are being looked at present.)

Note for musicians: If carrying a heavy instrument we suggest using Priory Street Multi Story Car Park. Unload first and then park.



WALKING FROM HASTINGS TRAIN STATION (8 min. walk)

Walk East from the station towards Station Approach and turn right onto Cornwallis Terrace. Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing. Follow the path on Priory Street, passing the 'Saga' building on your left. The OPUS THEATRE is the large grey building opposite - the entrance in on your right



PRIORY STREET MULTI STOREY CAR PARK (2 min. walk)


Open: 7am-11pm daily incl. disabled parking. 250 Parking spaces

Charges: £1.30 per hour (reduced thereafter) and free from 9pm to 11pm

Where: Located in the town centre in Hastings TN34 1NE and very popular with shoppers. It has direct access to Cambridge Road. CCTV monitored. Pay & Display option.

Directions: Leave Priory Street and walk towards Cambridge Road. You will see the OPUS Theatre opposite (the large Grade 2 listed building across the road, next to the glass fronted building).

This parking is ideal for musicians carrying heavy instruments - unload first and then park.



OTHER PARKING OPTIONS:

- TRINITY STREET (Street Parking): 3 min. walk £3 for 2 hours
- ROBERTSON STREET (Street Parking): 4 min. walk £3 for 2 hour Disabled bays available
- HOLMESDALE GARDENS (Street Parking): 4 min. walk Free for 2 hours, Pay & Display
- FALAISE HALL (Car Park): 5 min. walk down hill off Cambridge Road, Hastings TN34 1ES
- CARLISLE PARADE (Car Park): 6 min. walk Disabled parking available
